



Lift Zones in Colorado

As part of our ongoing commitment to help connect low-income individuals and families to the Internet, Comcast is equipping locations across Colorado with WiFi-connected “Lift Zones” before the end of 2021. Working with our network of nonprofit, community, and city partners, Comcast is providing robust WiFi in safe spaces for students and adults to get online, participate in digital literacy and workforce development trainings, and access critical resources.



The **COVID-19 crisis** has put many low-income students and adults at risk of being left behind and has accelerated the need for comprehensive digital equity and Internet adoption programs to support them. Lift Zones will be located across Colorado in Comcast’s service area.



This initiative will provide **free hotspot connectivity**, and access to hundreds of hours of educational and digital skills content. Lift Zones complement Comcast’s Internet Essentials program, which, since 2011, has helped connect more than 10 million low-income people to the Internet at home, including more than 480,000 low-income people in Colorado.
